

## Where Should I Be?!? CREDITS

- What is the Magic Number?
  - 24 Credit Plan: 18 18 Credit Plan: 12
- Credits & GPA only change AT SEMESTER
  - 3 credits are earned per semester\*
  - 6 credits per year\*
- If you are below credits:
  - eSchool & Extended School Day can provide additional credits
  - Recover failed credits

## Where Should I Be?!? GPA

- What is the Magic Number?
  - CUMULATIVE UNWEIGHTED GPA=2.0

#### If you are below a 2.0:

- your current classes must be all As, Bs and Cs.
- You CANNOT be earning lower than C for the semester
- B's or higher will bring your GPA up

- <u>All courses you take</u> count toward your GPA and class rank.
- If you are below 2.0: taking one extra elective online per semester can boost GPA.

### How do I Get There?! Academic Credits **To earn Academic Credits** (Math, Science, English, Social Studies) - Initial credits: Scheduled classes, eSchool, and/or **Extended School Day** – Semester grades of D or F - see Ms Pinsky: Credit Recovery Class **Extended School Day** Co-enrolled Adult Ed (semester of Eng or Math) Pasco eSchool or FLVS Summer School (will not graduate in June) Electives: Some failed academic electives can be recovered via APEX at Credit recovery class, extended school day, and/or summer school

## **Online Course DEADLINES**

- Do you have a full year online course?
  - you will go back into the classroom if you are not complete with semester 1 by January 4<sup>th</sup>.
- Do you have an eSchool Placeholder on your schedule?
  - If you have not taken and completed a class by end of 1<sup>st</sup> semester, you will be removed from that class.
- LAST DAY FOR SENIORS TO COMPLETE ALL ONLINE COURSES IS <u>END OF MARCH</u>. Failure to complete classes by the deadline will result in nonparticipation for graduation and/or delayed diploma.

**IF** the college to which you are applying requires a letter of recommendation from your school counselor

**THEN** do a **Request Form** for Counselor Letter of Recommendation

- FEW students need a counselor letter
- If required:
  - email <u>apinsky@pasco.k12.fl.us</u> & ask for the form
  - Provide at least 2 weeks advance notice of date needed

## Need to earn/recover credits

Steps to Apply:

- 1. Submit online application: Institutional, Common Application OR Coalition Application (only one application should be submitted)
- 2. Pay the application fee (or use fee waiver, if eligible)
- 3. ACT/SAT scores Request is done on the ACT or CollegeBoard websites
- 4. Academic Record
  - EITHER an official transcript requested through LOLHS website **OR** Self-Reported Student Academic Record (SSAR): Create an account on SSAR website and enter your academic record and link the SSAR to your college application
  - SSAR is **in place of** your transcript. Don't do both!

DON'T wait to apply! Many priority deadlines are in November!

## Financial Aid & Scholarships

FL State Scholarships and Grants/Florida Financial Aid Application Apply Now! Opened Oct. 1<sup>st</sup> Includes: Bright Futures Scholarship AND others! www.floridastudentfinancialaid.org

Florida Academic Scholarship 100% cost of tuition & fees covered

- GPA: 3.5 Weighted GPA (16 credits, weighted up to .5)
- SAT: 1330 or ACT: 29
- Community Service: 100 Hours

Florida Medallion Scholarship 75% cost of tuition & fees covered

- GPA: 3.0 Weighted GPA (16 credits, weighted up to .5)
- SAT: 1210 or ACT: 25
- Community Service: 75 Hours

## Financial Aid & Scholarships cont.

Free Application for Federal Student Aid

Includes: Need-based grants, student loans, work-study through Fed. Gov.

www.fafsa.gov

- Determines eligibility for need-based grants and work study
- Student loans only if needed
- Colleges can use the EFC (expected family contribution) from FAFSA to apply additional financial aid to you

<u>Private Scholarships</u> Organizations or companies who may have their own application and eligibility criteria
