Hepatitis A	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ages 19+: if risk factors are present</li> </ul>
Hepatitis B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ages 19+: if risk factors are present. <i>(Available at CareHere Health &amp; Wellness Center)</i></li> </ul>
Hepatitis C (HCV) Infection Screening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Physician recommendation based on past immunization or medical history</li> </ul>
Human Papillomavirus (HPV)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Physician recommendation based on past immunization or medical history</li> </ul>
Meningococcal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Age 19+: if risk factors are present.</li> </ul>
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Physician recommendation based on past immunization or medical history <i>(Available at CareHere Health &amp; Wellness Center)</i></li> </ul>
Pneumococcal Vaccine (PCV13 & PPSV23)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ages 19-64: if risk factors are present. Ages 65 +: 1-2 doses (per CDC). <i>(Available at CareHere Health &amp; Wellness Center)</i></li> <li><b>NEW. Age 50+: 1 dose (Florida Blue Benefits). Administered at participating pharmacies at no cost to you.</b></li> </ul>
Shingles (Zoster) Vaccine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Age 60+: 1 dose (per CDC). <i>(Available at CareHere Health &amp; Wellness Center)</i></li> <li><b>NEW. Age 50+: 1 dose. (Florida Blue Benefits). Administered at participating pharmacies at no cost to you.</b></li> <li>If your doctor does not supply the vaccine he/she can order from CVS Caremark Specialty Pharmacy. Please call 1-866-278-5108.</li> </ul>
Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (Td/Tdap)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Age 19+: Tdap vaccine once, then a Td booster every 10 yrs. <i>(Available at CareHere Health &amp; Wellness Center)</i></li> </ul>
Varicella (Chickenpox)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Physician recommendation based on past immunization or medical history.</li> </ul>
