A: Here's a list of some of the covered routine immunizations for children. Many of these vaccines are administered at the child's well visit.

Annual Flu Vaccine:		
 Administered at no cost to you at a: Participating Pediatrician's/Primary Care Physician's Office CareHere Health & Wellness Center for Children age 12 and older. Convenient Care Center (CCC), i.e., Participating Florida Hospital Express Care Clinics located inside the Walgreens Pharmacy.  Diphtheria, Tetanus, & Acellular Pertussis (DTaP) Hepatitis A & B Haemophilus Influenza Type B (Hib) Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) Inactivated Poliovirus Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) Meningococcal Pneumococcal PCV13 and PPSV23 Rotavirus Tetanus, Diphtheria & Acellular Pertussis (Tdap) Varicella (Chickenpox)

A: Here's a list of some of the immunizations covered, if medically necessary. These Vaccines/Immunizations are administered by a participating Primary Care Physician and/or Specialist, unless otherwise noted.

ADULT IMMUNIZATIONS	PLAN BENEFITS
Annual Flu Vaccine	 Administered at no cost to you at: CareHere Health & Wellness Center (HWC) In-network doctor's office Participating pharmacies, administered by the Pharmacist. In-network Convenient Care Center (CCC), i.e., Florida Hospital Express Care Clinics located inside the Walgreens Pharmacy. Please contact me for a list of participating CCC's in your area.
Haemophilus Influenzae Type B (Hib)	• Age 19+: if risk factors are present
Hepatitis A	• Ages 19+: if risk factors are present
Hepatitis B	• Ages 19+: if risk factors are present. (Available at CareHere HWC)
Hepatitis C (HCV) Infection Screening	Physician recommendation based on past immunization or medical history
Human Papillomavirus (HPV)	Physician recommendation based on past immunization or medical history
Meningococcal	• Age 19+: if risk factors are present.







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Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)	• Physician recommendation based on past immunization or medical history (<i>Available at CareHere HWC</i>)
Pneumococcal Vaccine (PCV13 & PPSV23)	 Ages 19-64: if risk factors are present. Ages 65 +: 1-2 doses (per CDC). (Available at CareHere HWC) Age 50+: 1 dose (Florida Blue Benefits). Administered at participating pharmacies by the pharmacist at no cost to you.
Shingles Vaccine New 2-Dose Series SHINGRIX (RZV) or Zoster Vaccine Live (ZVL)	 NEW 2-Dose Series SHINGRIX VACCINE is covered. (Available at CareHere HWC) Age 50+: SHINGRIX (RZV) covered by Florida Blue. Administered at participating pharmacies by the pharmacist. CDC recommendation: 1) Administer 2 doses of RZV 2-6 months apart to adults Age 50+ regardless of past episode of herpes zoster or receipt of ZVL. 2) Administer 2 doses of RZV 2-6 months apart to adults who previously received ZVL at least 2 months after ZVL. 3) For adults age 60+, administer either RZV (preferred) or ZVL. If your doctor does not supply the vaccine he/she can order from CVS/Caremark Specialty Pharmacy. Please call 1-866-278-5108.
Tetanus, Diptheria and Pertussis (Td/Tdap)	• Age 19+: Tdap vaccine once, then a Td booster every 10 yrs. (Available at CareHere HWC)
Varicella (Chickenpox)	Physician recommendation based on past immunization and medical history
