Q: Which child wellness services are covered?

Wellness Exam & Autism/Development Behavioral Assessment	 Newborn up to age 3: Frequent Wellness Check-ups Age 3-18: Annual Wellness Check-up
Body Mass Index (BMI): Height & Weight	Every visit, BMI beginning at age 2
Blood Pressure	Annually, beginning at age 3
Hearing Screenings	Newborn then annually beginning at Age 4

A: Here's a list of some of the covered routine immunizations for children. Many of these vaccines are administered at the child's well visit.

Annual Flu (Influenza) Vaccine:

- Diphtheria, Tetanus, & Acellular Pertussis (DTaP)
- Hepatitis A & B
- Haemophilus Influenza Type B (Hib)
- Human Papilloma Virus (HPV)
- Inactivated Poliovirus
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- Meningococcal
- Pneumococcal PCV13 and PPSV23
- Rotavirus
- Tetanus, Diphtheria & Acellular Pertussis (Tdap)
- Varicella (Chickenpox)
