- Q: What are the operating hours of Guidewell Emergency Medicine Doctors?
- A: The locations are open Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., and Saturday and Sunday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Please call to verify. No appointment is necessary.
- Q: What can Guidewell Emergency Medicine Doctors provide?
- A: Guidewell Emergency Medicine Doctors can provide:



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- Board-Certified emergency medicine doctors and bilingual health professionals
- Care for major conditions: chest pain, abdominal pain, head and neck injuries, fractures, etc.
- Care for minor conditions: cough, colds, flu, ear infections, sprains, etc.
- On-site diagnostic services: CT scan, X-ray, ultrasound and lab work available at all locations
- Admission directly into an in-network hospital when necessary. Patients are picked up by ambulance and taken directly to a hospital, bypassing the ER waiting room
- Faster care: on average, just 1 hour compared to 2 hours 23 minutes at
- Complete follow-up care: Coordination of follow-up with your doctor, specialist, or hospital
- When I use Guidewell Emergency Medicine Doctors will I receive two bills; one Q: from the hospital and the other from the ER physician, radiologist, etc.?
- A: No, you will receive only one bill that includes all diagnostic evaluations, procedures, lab work, physician examinations and other services provided at the facility.
- Q: What will my copay be for services rendered at Guidewell Emergency Medicine Doctors?
- A: Since Guidewell Emergency Medicine Doctors is a Value Choice Urgent Care Provider the first 2 visits in a calendar year are \$0 copay. The remaining visits are \$50 copay per visit regardless of which plan you are enrolled in. If you go to the ER it would be a \$300 copay/visit and you can expect additional bills from the ER physician, Radiologist, etc. under the HMO Basic and PPO Standard Plans.
