# Cancer Screenings




## Lung

According to the National Comprehensive Cancer Network, it's time for a lung cancer screening, if you are:

- 50 years of age or older, and
- A current or former smoker with at least a 20 pack-year\* smoking history, and
- Have no signs or symptoms of lung cancer

A Low-Dose Computed Tomography (LDCT) screening can be done in one minute and does not require any needles or preparation. **To coordinate your lung screening or for more information, email [LungScreening@Moffitt.org](mailto:LungScreening@Moffitt.org).**

\* *Pack-year = Number of packs smoked per day X Number of years smoking.*  
*Example: smoked 1 pack per day for 20 years, 2 packs per day for 10 years, etc.*



## Skin

Moffitt's Mole Patrol® program offers free mobile skin cancer screenings and cancer education to the public. Screenings are conducted in an area that allows for some measure of privacy when needed. ## Screening Mammogram

The purpose of a mammography screening is to find breast cancer at its earliest, most treatable stages. Studies have shown that regular annual mammography screening of women with no symptoms of breast cancer has lowered the number of women who die from the disease by about 30 percent. The American College of Radiology (ACR) and the Society of Breast Imaging (SBI) recommend that women of average breast cancer risk begin screening at age 40.

Moffitt does breast cancer risk evaluation at the time of a screening mammogram. A screening mammogram does not require a prescription; however, please list a provider to send the report to. If your last mammogram was not done at Moffitt, we will need the images for your prior mammograms (preferably 3-5 years' worth) at the time of your appointment. **To schedule your screening mammogram appointment, call 888-456-2838.**
