

Developmental Milestones



Check the milestones your baby
has reached by 2 months

What most babies do by this age

Movement/Physical Development Milestones

- Holds head up when on tummy
- Moves both arms and both legs
- Opens hands briefly

Social/Emotional Milestones

- Calms down when spoken to or picked up
- Looks at your face
- Seems happy to see you when you walk up to her
- Smiles when you talk to or smile at her

Language/Communication Milestones

- Makes sounds other than crying
- Reacts to loud sounds

Cognitive Milestones (learning, thinking, problem-solving)

- Watches you as you move
- Looks at a toy for several seconds

Help Your Baby Learn & Grow

- Respond positively to your baby. Act excited, smile, and talk to him when he makes sounds. This teaches him to take turns “talking” back and forth in conversation.
- Talk, read, and sing to your baby to help her develop and understand language.
- Spend time cuddling and holding your baby. This will help him feel safe and cared for. You will not spoil your baby by holding or responding to him.
