Effective January 1, 2024, Teladoc Health is a new benefit Pasco County School Board added. Please review the following FAQs for more information.

Dear Patty:

Q: Who is Teladoc?

- A: Teledoc is an independent company contracted by Florida Blue to provide physician visits via phone or online video to member with non-emergent medical issues.
- Q: Which type of physicians do I have access to?
- A: You have access to U.S. board-certified clinicians such as General Medicine Physicians, Dermatologists, and Behavioral Health Specialists.
- Q: Is Teladoc available outside of Florida?
- A: Yes, you may use Teladoc outside of Florida, but not outside of the United States.
- Q: What types of conditions can be treated by a Teladoc General Physician?



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- A: They can treat conditions like the flu, bronchitis, rashes, sinus infections and more.
- Q: What is the copay for a Teladoc visit?
- A: It varies by the type of doctor. General Medicine is \$10 copay per visit. Dermatologist and Behavioral Health Specialists are \$25 copay per visit.
- Q: How do I get started?
- A: First, you should register on www.teladoc.com. Click here for instructions. You will need to provide a brief medical history and list of current medications. I recommend setting up your account before you need the services. Also, the Teledoc App is available too.
- What is the phone number for Teladoc? Q:
- A: The phone number is 1-800-TELEDOC (800-835-2362).
- Q: Is there a minimum age for the Behavioral Health Teledoc visit?
- A: Yes, the minimum age is 18 years and older.



- Q: Can the Teledoc physician prescribe medications?
- A: Yes, they can prescribe medications other than controlled substances.
