Withlacoochee River Electric Educational Foundation Scholarship

Amount: \$1,375 per semester (maximum of \$11,000)

Date Due: 3/14/18 Grade: 12th

Requirements: Be a high school senior with a minimum 2.0 GPA; Be bona fide residents

within the service area of Withlacoochee River Electric Cooperative, Inc. for at least one year prior to December 31st; Be the dependent of a WREC member; Plan to attend an in-state college, university, or technical school

full time (minimum of 12 credits per semester); Schools must be accredited by one of the six regional accrediting institutions, such as SACS, recognized by the Council on Higher Education Accreditation. If institution is a technical school, it should be accredited by the Council on Occupational Education or its equivalent; Maintain a 2.0 GPA (each semester or higher if mandated by the institution) to maintain eligibility;

Amount: \$1,250 (two awards; one male and one female)

Date Due: 4/1/18 Grade: 12th

Requirements: Current Land O' Lakes High School senior; Minimum of a 3.0 GPA; Must

have played a sport this school year; Have accrued at least 25 hours of community service; Be involved in clubs/extra-curricular activities *in*

addition to athletics; Have been accepted into a

university/state/community college.

Requirements: The Project Weather Scholarship is a one-time award given to one

student attending a public, private, home, or parochial school in EACH of the following counties: Citrus, Hernando, Hillsborough, Manatee, Pasco, Pinellas, and Polk. Ro be eligible for the contest an applicant must: have

earned a minimum PGPA of 3.5; Be a 12th grade student.
