- ON TRACK=2.0
 - CUMULATIVE IS FOR GRADUATION
 - WEIGHTED IS FOR COLLEGES
- Q1 + Q2=SEMESTER 1; Q3 + Q4= SEMESTER 2
- Semester grades are what are reported on academic transcripts
- C'S AND ABOVE!

STATE ASSESSMENTS

- ALG 1 EOC: If didn't pass it yet, you can earn these concordant scores on these assessments:
 - SAT-420
 - ACT-16
- 10TH GRADE READING FSA: if didn't pass yet, you can earn concordant scores on these:
 - SAT-430 Evidence based reading and writing OR 24 on Reading subtest
 - ACT-19 (OR AVERAGE 18 ON ENGLISH & READING)
 - You can sign yourself up at sat.org & act.org
- EOCs for US HISTORY, BIO, GEO: Worth 30% of final grade
 - DO NOT have to pass for graduation but must sit (exception : if earned credit out of state)
 - Additional exception: EOC was waived if you took US Hist, Bio, Geo during 19-20 school year
 - Must still meet math test requirement if taken during 2019-20 (either through Alg1EOC or Geo EOC)
