

Tips for Completing the Dynamic Form (a.k.a. Online Request Form)

Bring with you the worksheet to your meeting with your high school counselor, along with all the classes you are considering for FALL term next year.

- Go to <https://admissions.phsc.edu/start/high-school/dual-enroll/charter-public> and click on the link “2021 Fall Dual Enrollment Request Form for Charter and Public Schools” on the right-hand side.
- The dynamic form should include **ALL** of the DE classes that you plan to take during the fall term (@LOLHS, @PHSC, or online @PHSC).
- The following Dual Enrollment courses will be offered through Pasco eSchool:
 - SPC 2608 - Introduction to Public Speaking
 - CGS 1100 - Computer MicroApplications
 - GEB 1011 - Introduction to Business
 - GEB 2122 - Introduction to Business and Entrepreneurship

Per the agreement between PHSC and district, any student who wants to take the courses listed above will be required to take them through Pasco eSchool. You will still have a PHSC Off-Campus placeholder on your schedule for the course even though it will be taken through Pasco eSchool, so you still need transportation to leave campus. **IMPORTANT: If you put one of the courses listed above (SPC 2608, CGS 1100, GEB 1011, GEB 2122) on your dynamic form, select “high school campus” as the campus. This will allow district to register you for the course.**

This means that if you complete a dynamic form for the above 4 classes, you do not have to register for them on 8/2.

- The following Dual Enrollment courses will be offered at Land O’ Lakes next fall. Be sure to include the course(s) that you requested when we did course selection on your dynamic form:
 - ENC 1101 – English Comp 1
 - AMH2010 – History of the United States from 1763 to 1865 if you didn’t yet earn your high school US History credit
 - ~~LIT 1020 – Intro to Short Fiction only if you have completed ENC 1101~~ LIT 1020 & ENG2 103 are NOT on the master schedule
 - ~~ENG 2103 – World Cinema only if you have completed ENC 1101~~

- If you requested a PHSC Off Campus placeholder for next year, you plan to take a DE course that we do not offer at LOLHS. When you enter your classes on the dynamic form, **add as many courses as possible** to increase your chances of getting a class. (Some classes at PHSC may fill up before it is your turn to register. It’s recommended to have many backup options!)
- If you do not care if you take a course online or on campus, choose “PHSC on campus or online” to increase the number of sections available to you when it is time for registration. **This only applies to classes that you will be taking through PHSC online or on one of their campuses. You will select “high school campus” for the classes offered at LOLHS or through Pasco eSchool.**

REMEMBER: You cannot be ON campus during the periods you have PHSC OFF-campus placeholders in your LOLHS schedule. Ensure reliable transportation for all semester.
