A: Here's a list of some of the covered routine immunizations for children. Many of these vaccines are administered at the child's well visit.

Annual Flu Vaccine	Administered at no cost to you at: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CareHere Health & Wellness Center (HWC) • In-network doctor's office • Participating pharmacies, administered by the Pharmacist. • In-network Convenient Care Center (CCC), i.e., Florida Hospital Express Care Clinics located inside the Walgreens Pharmacy. Please contact me for a list of participating CCC's in your area.
Haemophilus Influenzae Type B (Hib)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Age 19+: if risk factors are present
Hepatitis A	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ages 19+: if risk factors are present
Hepatitis B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ages 19+: if risk factors are present. <i>(Available at CareHere HWC)</i>
Hepatitis C (HCV) Infection Screening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Physician recommendation based on past immunization or medical history
Human Papillomavirus (HPV)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Physician recommendation based on past immunization or medical history
Meningococcal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Age 19+: if risk factors are present.

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<p>Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Physician recommendation based on past immunization or medical history (<i>Available at CareHere HWC</i>)
<p>Pneumococcal Vaccine (PCV13 & PPSV23)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ages 19-64: if risk factors are present. Ages 65 +: 1-2 doses (per CDC). (<i>Available at CareHere HWC</i>) Age 50+: 1 dose (Florida Blue Benefits). Administered at participating pharmacies by the pharmacist at no cost to you.
<p>Shingles Vaccine New 2-Dose Series SHINGRIX (RZV) or Zoster Vaccine Live (ZVL)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>NEW 2-Dose Series SHINGRIX VACCINE is covered. (Available at CareHere HWC)</i> Age 50+: SHINGRIX (RZV) covered by Florida Blue. Administered at participating pharmacies by the pharmacist. CDC recommendation: 1) Administer 2 doses of RZV 2-6 months apart to adults Age 50+ regardless of past episode of herpes zoster or receipt of ZVL. 2) Administer 2 doses of RZV 2-6 months apart to adults who previously received ZVL at least 2 months after ZVL. 3) For adults age 60+, administer either RZV (preferred) or ZVL. If your doctor does not supply the vaccine he/she can order from CVS/Caremark Specialty Pharmacy. Please call 1-866-278-5108.
<p>Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (Td/Tdap)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Age 19+: Tdap vaccine once, then a Td booster every 10 yrs. (<i>Available at CareHere HWC</i>)
<p>Varicella (Chickenpox)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Physician recommendation based on past immunization and medical history
